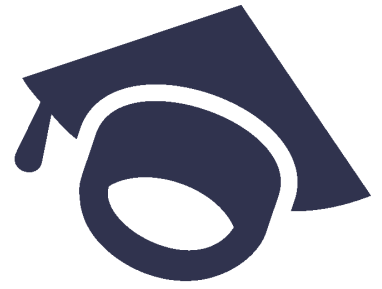


# 10 South Dakota High School College and Career Readiness Websites We Love
