FRUIT LOOP LACING



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Colors, patterns, lacing, oh my! Make a fruit loop necklace with your child. To start, thread a hole through and tie a knot through one fruit loop. Here are three ways this helps with school readiness:

- If your child can already name all the colors, challenge them to come up with words that rhyme with the colors even if they are made up words. Rhyming is an early reading skill.
- Patterns are a kindergarten math skill. Try making an ABABAB pattern: pick two colors and alternate the colors.
- Lacing builds hand eye coordination and small hand muscle development that will make writing, zipping, getting dressed, cutting, buttoning, and tying shoes so much easier.

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
