SUNFLOWER SCIENCE



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Watching a seed sprout above ground is a fun way to practice the science skills of curiosity, prediction, and observation. It's also a great opportunity to learn where our plants and food come from!

- Dampen the paper towel and place the seeds 1 inch from the bottom of the bag.
- Seal the plastic bag except for a 1 inch gap at the corner.
- Tape the bag to a sunny window with the seeds facing indoors.
- Ask your child to predict what will happen next.
- Once the seeds have formed roots and stems, plant them into soil and watch them grow!

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
