Create-Your-Own Photo Booth

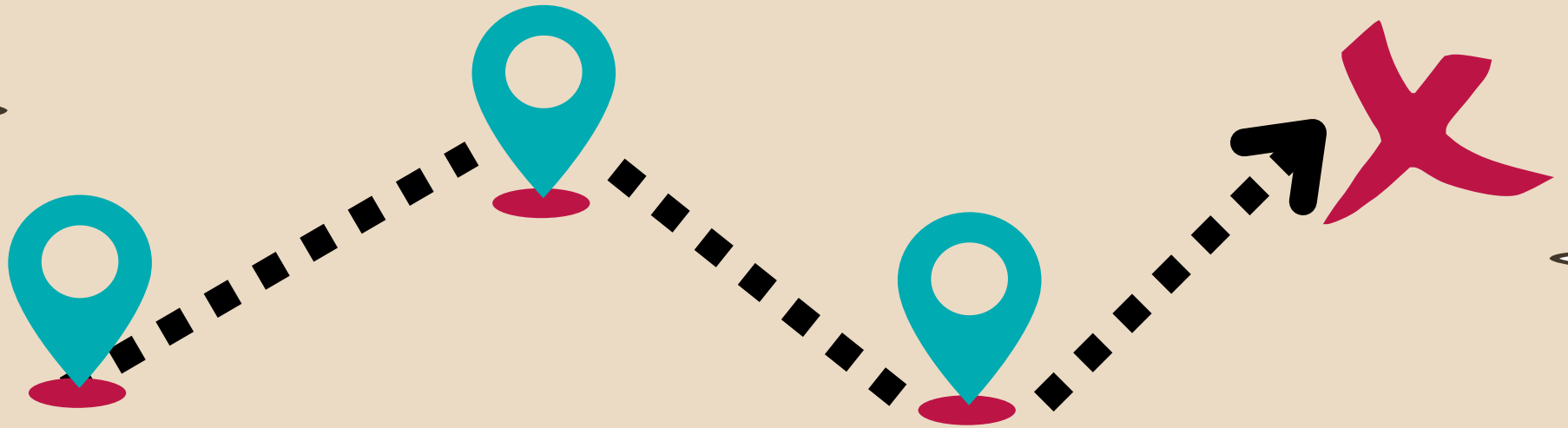
- Print and cut out any of the following pages to create a fun photo booth to capture memories. The last seven pages are Spanish translations.
